

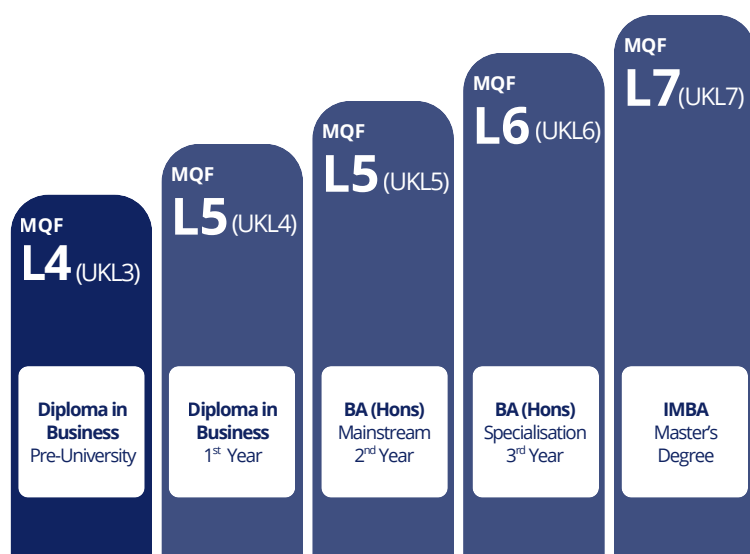
# Diploma in Business

## Diploma in Business (L3DB)

### Advanced Basics for Business

This module provides conceptual and practical learning about the world of business and how it operates. Students learn about how business and other organisations work, from exploring their operations issues, their customers and marketing. Students also learn about the external environment and how this helps shape how businesses respond to global challenges. This encompasses the economic and political context in which businesses operate, as well their ethical and legal responsibilities.

### Developing Financial Forecasting and Accounting in Business

In this module, learners are introduced to the types of costs that different businesses incur. This includes the management of costs and revenue to generate a profit, understanding break even analysis and financial forecasting within a business, and how a business prepares and manages the accounting process.

### Developing Organisational Structure

This module covers how structural decisions help exert control in the different environments that organisations need to operate in. By the end of this course, students will have a comprehensive understanding of how organisational structure influences a wider range of factors including strategy, culture, decision-making and communication.

### Developing Entrepreneurship Skills

This module aims to enhance candidate understanding of what entrepreneurship means and how forms of entrepreneurship can make a positive impact on economy and society. It aims to equip students with an entrepreneurial mindset that helps them make better career decisions—either in the work place or as an independent entrepreneur—and cope effectively with increasingly rapid changes in economy and society.
